

DESIGNATION AS IMPAIRED AGENT UNDER
TEXAS INSURANCE CODE CHAPTER 2602

General remarks and official action taken:

On this day came on for consideration by the Commissioner of Insurance the matter of Ameritrust Title Company ("Ameritrust Title"), organized and doing insurance business in the State of Texas. On March 20, 2009, the 261st District Court of Travis County, Texas entered an Agreed Order Appointing Liquidator and Permanent Injunction in Cause No. D-1-GV-08-002014, finding Ameritrust Title to be insolvent.

Based upon the finding of insolvency by the Travis County District Court and having considered the purposes of TEX. INS. CODE Ch. 2602, the Commissioner of Insurance finds that Ameritrust Title should be, and is hereby, designated as an impaired agent as that term is defined in TEX. INS. CODE § 2602.003(5), effective March 20, 2009.
